Generic job description:

- plan and teach courses
- prepare, administer and mark student assignments and examinations
- advise students regarding course and academic matters
- supervise graduate students
- conduct research studies and publish their findings or create or perform works of art, depending on their discipline
- advising students regarding academic requirements and options

Skills:

- Excellent oral and written communication skills, including the ability to present complex, in-depth materials at a student level.
- Co-ordinating information in innovative ways to prepare teaching materials, supervising and evaluating student progress
- Desire to learn and share their knowledge with others
- Critical thinking skills
- Enthusiasm for their subject or skill area
- Respect for people from diverse backgrounds

Qualifications:

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Teaching experience in a post-secondary environment
- BA degree or higher, Master's degree in a related discipline is an asset
- Demonstrate experience in teaching with an ongoing interest in research in the discipline
